Brunswick Methodist Church

Opened in 1820, Brunswick Methodist Church situated in Brunswick Place at the heart of the city of Newcastle upon Tyne, replaced the 'Orphan House' which had been built by John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, in 1742

Initially built as a preaching centre with room for 1300 worshippers, the building was radically altered in the early 1980s to provide a 450 seating capacity sanctuary upstairs, new hall and rooms, a suite of offices and a sandwich bar which has recently been enlarged and refurbished. The re-design and refurbishment gave the building a whole new lease of life and a much greater flexibility to more effectively serve the needs of the local community.

Open seven days a week the building pulses with activity and with the hundreds who flock through the doors on a weekly basis to attend one of the regular user groups or perhaps a seminar or the coffee shop or a concert. For a building that many pass by without a second thought it is well used by both local folks and those who come from greater distances.
